Wellness Testing can:

- Help you monitor your health risks based on family history
- Help you monitor and manage existing health conditions
- Provide information helpful in planning healthy lifestyle changes.
- Be used in conjunction with your health care provider.
- Be used as a means of establishing “normal” baseline lab results.

Why have Testing done?

- Symptoms can often be explained by lab test results, and sometimes abnormal results will be indicated before symptoms appear.
- The Wellness Testing offered by MLS are the same tests doctors often order for yearly blood tests.
- MLS is locally owned thus your blood is not shipped out of state. Turn around time for results are 2-3 days after the Wellness draw.
- Wellness Testing is being offered at a reduced rate. Normally the Wellness Profile offered to the general public cost \$73.00
- Our phlebotomists are gentle, kind and have many years of experience.
- An informative pamphlet will be provided with the results to help explain the lab tests.

Quick Description of Tests Being Offered:

- **Chemistry Profile** offers over 20 tests. These tests help to evaluate kidney, thyroid, muscle, cardiac, & liver functions. The tests can also help to indicate diabetes, gout, anemia and coronary risk factors.
- **Lipid Profile** is essentially the good, bad, and the ugly of cholesterol results.
- **CBC** results can indicate an infection, anemia, clotting problems, viral infections or allergies.
- **hTSH (hypersensitive Thyroid Stimulating Hormone)** is the pituitary hormone which controls the thyroid gland function. Malfunction is most often found in women. Common signs of having thyroid problems can be weight loss, weight gain, hair loss, extreme fatigue.
- **PSA (Prostatic Specific Antigen)** screens for prostate cancer in males.
- **Glycohemoglobin (A₁C)** is used in monitoring known diabetics. It is an excellent indicator of glucose levels over the last 4-6 weeks.
- **hsCRP** “is sometimes used in patients with inflammatory bowel disease and some forms of arthritis and autoimmune diseases to assess how active the inflammation is and to monitor the treatment. The CRP test is also used to monitor patients after surgery or other invasive procedures to detect the presence of an infection during the recovery period. CRP tests are not specific enough to diagnose a particular disease. Rather, CRP is a general marker of infection and inflammation that alerts medical professionals that further testing and treatment may be necessary “ -- www.labtestsonline.com
